FEDERAL CLEAN ENERGY TAX CREDITS

Here's a list compiled from the IRS, ENERGY STAR, and the U.S. Climate Alliance (a bipartisan coalition of governors) of federal tax credits that are still available under the IRA, along with the new deadlines for eligibility as of August 2025.

- [New electric vehicle](#): Up to \$7,500 for qualifying vehicles purchased through Sept. 30, 2025
- [Used electric vehicle](#): Up to \$4,000 for qualifying vehicles purchased through Sept. 30, 2025
- [Air source heat pump for building heating and A/C](#): Up to \$2,000 for installations through Dec. 31, 2025. For those considering heat pumps, The Associated Press has a useful [guide](#).
- [Ground source heat pump for building heating and A/C](#): 30% off qualifying costs with no cap for installations through Dec. 31, 2025
- [Heat pump water heater](#): Up to \$2,000 For installations through Dec. 31, 2025.
- Building weatherization – [insulation](#), [doors](#), [windows](#): up to \$1,200 for installations through Dec. 31, 2025 See links for whether aggregate job limits apply
- [Electrical panel](#): Up to \$600 for installations through Dec. 31, 2025
- [Home energy audit](#), used to pinpoint where you're losing energy and how to save: Up to \$150 through Dec. 31, 2025
- [Rooftop Solar](#): 30% off qualifying costs with no cap for purchases made through Dec. 31, 2025
- [Battery storage](#): 30% off qualifying costs with no cap for purchases made through Dec. 31, 2025
- [Electric vehicle charger](#): Up to \$1,000 for chargers placed in service before June 30, 2026

--Most tax incentives are for 30% of qualifying costs, up to the maximum tax credits listed above.
--Some of these tax credits are also available for businesses.

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
